

**Report on**  
**International Symposium on Sustainable Polymers**  
**and Launch of SPSI-North East Chapter & SPSI-MACRO-2020**

Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati, Department of Chemical Engineering has successfully organized three-days International Symposium on Sustainable Polymers from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 as part of the Silver Jubilee Celebration of IIT Guwahati.
