- 7) Co-operate and maintain a liaison with other organizations and learned bodies in India abroad having similar objectives.
- 8) Assist universities and other teaching and research institutions in planning education and research in polymers and ensuring the appropriate standard thereof.
- 9) Institute awards, studentship, scholarship and other benefaction to qualified persons.
- 10) Create an impact of the society all over the country by opening chapters in various cities of the country where reasonable number of scientists / technologies are interested.
- 11) Undertake and execute all other acts that are incidental and conductive to the attainment of anyone or more of the above mentioned objectives

All the incomes, earnings, movable or immovable properties of the society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objectives only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the society or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members.

Copies of the annual accounts of the trust/institution/association along with details of investment (including deposits) and utilization, if any, of the money so accumulated or set apart will be furnished to you before the expiry of six months commencing from the end of each relevant previous year.

It is requested that in view of our complying with the conditions laid down in section 11(2) of the income-tax Act, 1961, the benefit of that section may be given in the assessments of the trust exempting the income in respect of the trust/institution/association in respect of the incomes accumulated or set apart as mentioned above.





1 Background of the trust

The Society for Polymer Science India is a "Trust" in Pune registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 on August 16, 2001 at Pune. Trust's objective is to promote the general advancement of Science and technology of Polymer in the country, and to provide a forum for exchange of information amongst the members and persons attached to the society. It shall be an educational, scientific, non - political and not profit making organisation catering to the needs of its members from various disciplines of science engineering and technology.

2 Significant Accounting Policies used in preparation and presentation of accounts

3 Basis of Preparation of financial statements

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, on the accrual basis of accounting and in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in India.

4 Method of Accounting

Accounts are kept on double entry system and under mercantile system. The entity follows accrual system of accounting and recognises income and expenditure as and when accrues or incurs.

5 Revenue Recognition

Interest on bank deposits is accounted on accrual basis.
Income from sponsorship receipts is recognised as per terms of contract on accrual basis.
Other income is recognised in accrual basis.

6 Investments

Investments are stated at cost

7 Liabilities

All Known liabilities are provided for.

The entity applied for being registered as a charitable organisation in March 2016 before the income tax authorities. The trust has received recognition as a charitable organisation vide order of the CIT dated September 29, 2016 u/s 12A of the Income tax act.

There were no any activities and transactions carried out at Trivendrum chapter of entity during the year, therefore the same have not been considered in the underlying financial statements.

Compliance relating to tax deducted at source are not complied with and therefore TDS was not deducted on any payments.
